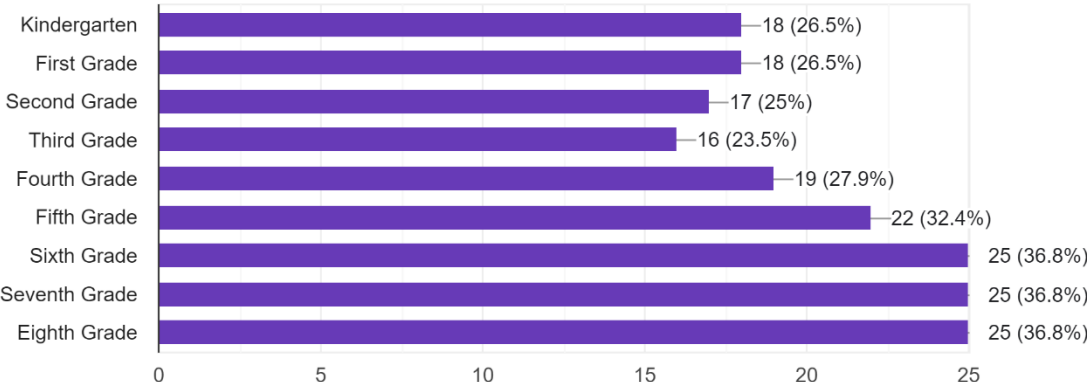

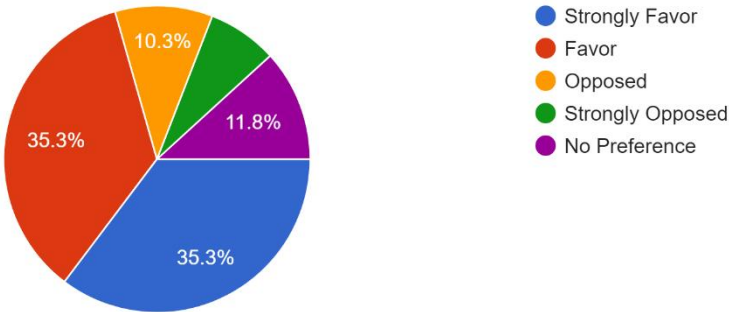
In which grade(s) do you teach? (Check all that apply)

Would you be in favor of a four-day school week?

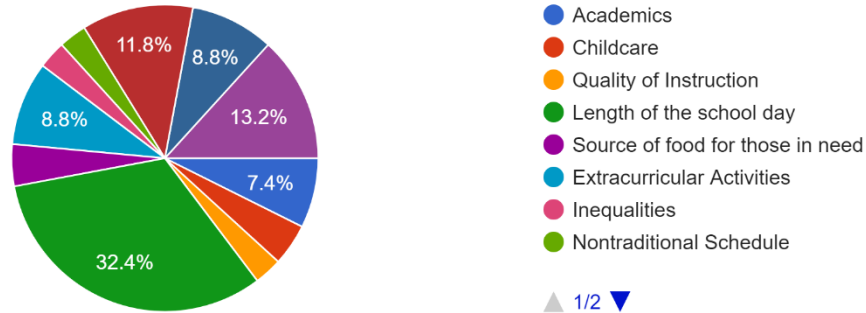

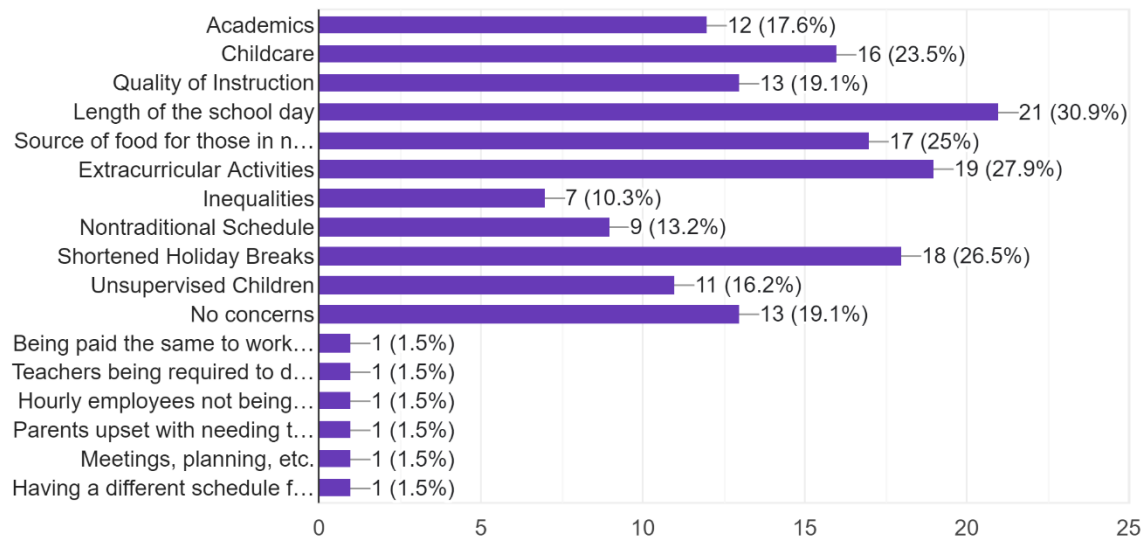
What is your greatest concern with a possible four-day school week? (Salaried individuals compensation is not affected by a 4-day work week schedule.)

What other concerns do you have with a possible four-day school week? (Salaried individuals compensation is not affected by a 4-day work week schedule.)

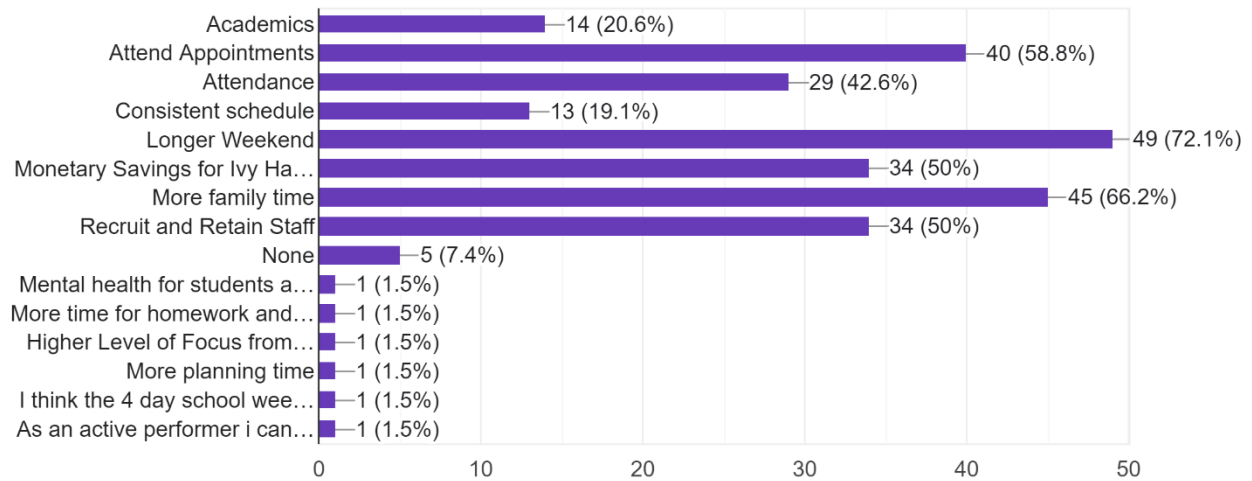

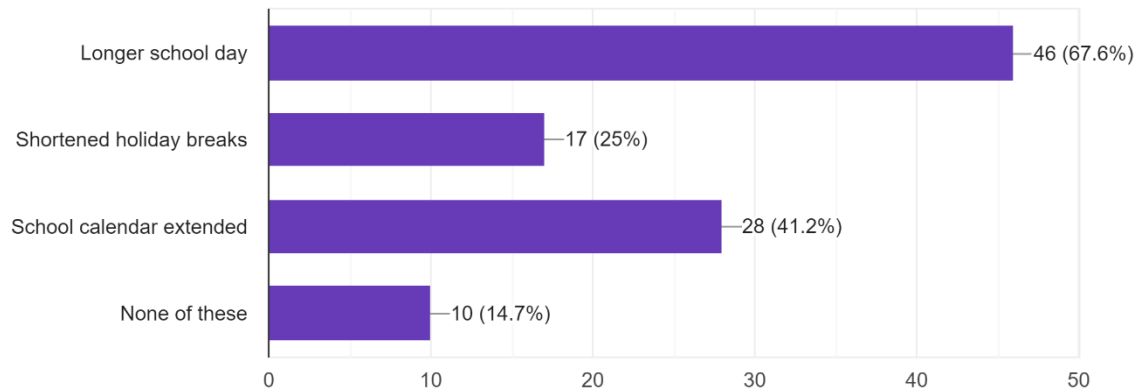
What do you see as positive aspects of a four-day week?

A four-day week means that school days may be longer, holidays may be shortened, and possibly more days added to the end of the calendar year. Pl...e willing to accept to have a four-day school week.

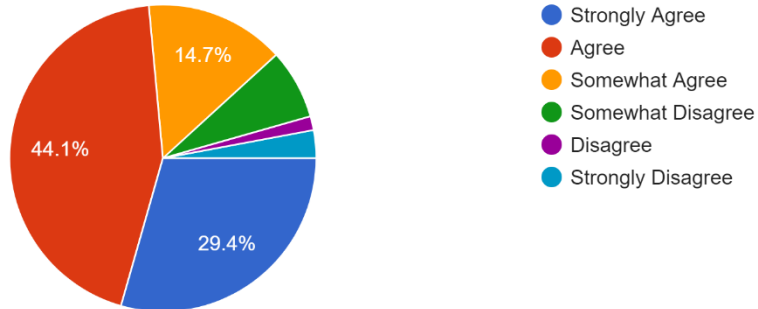

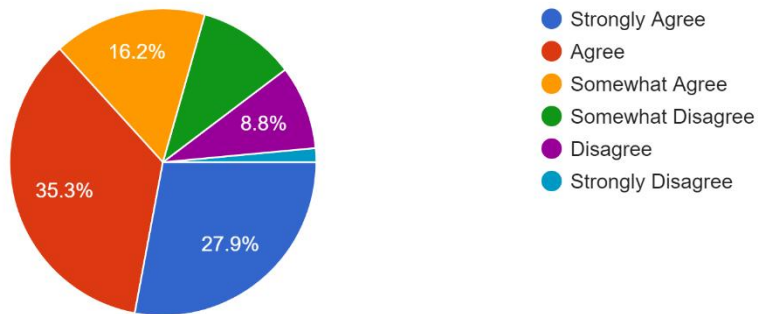
A more consistent weekly school schedule will benefit student learning. (For example, Early Release Wednesdays and Teacher Duty Days that do not fall on a holiday.)

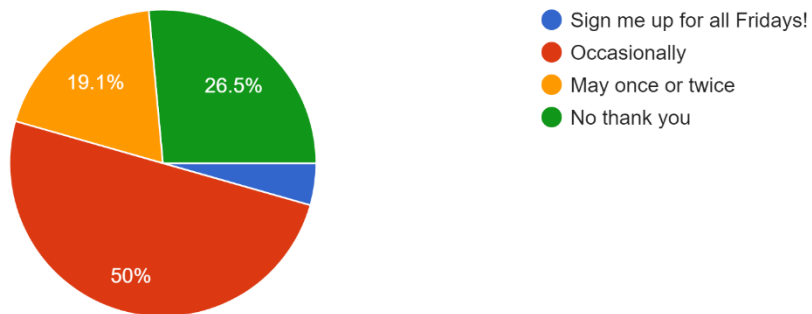
The four-day week will improve student attendance.

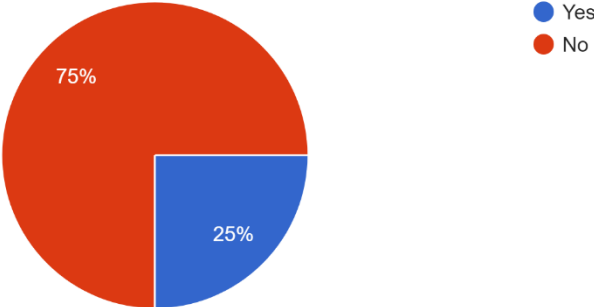
